**Chris-** He said that he heard from a reliable source that the Shrimp Farm is Dumping Millions of gallons of salt water into the East Marsh Canal! He would like to find out if anyone can do a test of the water because it will kill the Vegetation and fish. If anyone has any suggestions on how to get the water tested please let me know.

**John** -From the Indian River Bass Association was asking us if we are having any issues with the Tour Boats? Are they affecting us being able to load and unload at the boat ramp, or with fishing & frogging? He said that he has been fishing and frogging in Garcia's since they opened and he and others have noticed a huge decline in fishing and he believes that it is due to all the Tour Boats tearing up the vegetation and fish beds and causing the water to be very dirty. Sam personally was concerned about the issue for fear they would close it to all recreational airboating but he now knows that they are not blaming the recreational airboaters. Several people said that the property was put there for recreational use for <u>everyone</u> to use but that does not seem to be the case lately because of all the tour boats making money off the public land and something needs to be done before someone gets hurt due to all the traffic out there.

#### > Club Meeting Pot

We started the pot with \$218.00 which rolled over from the last meeting and we collected \$25.00 from members this month making the new pot \$243.00.
